**Pastoral Care Team:** (Making Lay Eucharistic Visits, other visits, cards, phone calls)

**Stewardship Team:** (Paying pledges; generously responding to appeals for a new HVAC system; increasing the St. Francis pledge to the diocese; completing reports and audits)

**Search for a new Priest-in-Charge:** (Many meetings and much prayer)

**On Saturday morning, September 10** we will cease the doing and focus on prayer for our parish and our search for a new Priest-in-Charge as well as offer prayers for our nation (and victims) on the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the tragedy of the terrorist attacks of 9-11-01. ## COLUMBARIUM NEWS



Gordon Combs of McLamb Monument met with the vestry at its July meeting to discuss a new design to replace the panels in the Columbarium that have become unglued. Gordon's idea was to install one single panel of black granite secured to the wall with bolts, but Rick and other vestry members expressed concern about debris collecting between the panel and the curved brick wall. Charlotte wondered about the vulnerability of a single panel during freezing weather.

We asked Gordon to consider some alternative materials and design. In the meantime, the church's insurance company has sent a check that will help greatly in replacing the broken panels. Thanks to all of you who responded to this breakage with donations. We hope soon to make the central panel attractive again. If any of you has ideas about a centerpiece, please share them with Liz Meador at 735-2316 or [lizmeador@earthlink.net](mailto:lizmeador@earthlink.net). While we are disappointed about the damage, the breakage is an opportunity to match the side panels of black granite or consider another idea for the focal point.

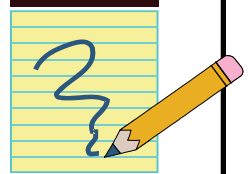

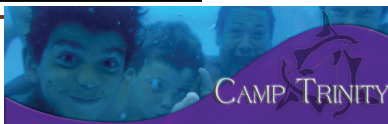
**Attention Camp Trinity Parents: Be on the look out for summer 2012 early registration in November 2011!**
